The 2013 BeNA Lecture Series will be given by Daniel S. Hamermesh. He is Sue Killam Professor in the Foundations of Economics at the University of Texas at Austin and Professor of Economics, Royal Holloway University of London. He has taught at Michigan State University, Princeton, Harvard and numerous universities across Europe, Asia and Australia. He received his undergraduate degree from the University of Chicago and his PhD from Yale. He is fellow of the Econometric Society and a research associate of the NBER and IZA.

Prof. Hamermesh has published on a wide range of topics in top journals such as *American Economic Review*, *Journal of Political Economy*, *Quarterly Journal of Economics, Journal of Labor Economics and Review of Economics and Statistics*. His research has focused on labor demand, time use, discrimination and unusual applications of labor economics (to suicide, sleep and beauty).

The third and fourth lectures (Applications and Policy) take place on


