Submissions

to ebe-summer-meeting@econ.lmu.de. Please send your paper as a PDF file in the format [lastname_firstname_field.pdf]. For field, please choose either *applied economics*, *experimental economics*, or *behavioral theory*.

The full paper version of your submission is due on 15 May 2018 if you submitted an extended abstract. Acceptance notifications will be sent out by mid-March 2018.

Costs

There is no conference fee. Conference meals and accommodation will be covered for invited participants. In cases where financial assistance is not available from a researcher's university, we may be able to offer a limited number of travel grants.
