

Tenure-Track-Position „Dynamic Macroeconomics“

40h/week, to start on January 1st, 2019

Limited for 6 years (extendable) with possible qualification agreement

The Institute of Statistics and Mathematical Methods in Economics (Research Group Economics) at the TU Wien invites applications for a tenure-track-position “Dynamic Macroeconomics” (salary group B1) for 40h per week to start on January 1st, 2019 up to December 31st, 2024.

The monthly minimum salary for this position is currently EUR 3.711,10 gross (14x per year). With completion of the qualification agreement the salary classification increases to A2 with a monthly minimum salary of EUR 4.388,70 gross (14x per year).

This position is initially limited to 6 years but can be extended to a permanent employment as an Associate Professorship if the requirements of the qualification agreement are fulfilled.

Conditions of Admission: The candidate must hold an appropriate PhD (mathematical economics/ economics). Ideally she/he should have been active as post-doc and have international experience. The winning candidate does have outstanding scientific achievements and publications with special focus on Macroeconomics.

Professional Orientation: We are looking for outstanding researchers with interests in research and teaching, who are also able to research on their own in the field of dynamic models in mathematical economics with a special focus on dynamic macroeconomics. Also a high potential for a continued successful academic career is encouraged.

Further Skills: In addition to the work of the own research areas a connection to the topics of the research group "Economics" (<http://www.econ.tuwien.ac.at>) is desired. Experience in the realization of university courses and the supervision of students as well as the acquisition of research and third-party funded projects will be considered as valuable asset. It is expected that the winning candidate will hold courses in micro- and macroeconomics at the TU Wien independently. Teaching experience in German is an advantage.

Application Information: The application should include the following documents

- Application letter, German or English, not longer than 5 pages should be about
 - Description of past and planned research
 - Description of past and planned teaching

- Certificate of academic titles

- List of Teaching and Supervision Work
