Submissions

The EBE Summer Meeting will feature both presentations and poster sessions. We invite PhD students to submit full papers or **extended abstracts (3-4 pages)**. **Each paper presentation will be discussed by another participant.**

The full paper version of your submission is due **on June 1** if you submitted an extended abstract and received an acceptance for a presentation session. Acceptance notifications will be sent out by **mid-March 2020.**

Best Paper Award

The best paper submitted and presented at the conference will be awarded a prize of **EUR 300**. The best papers will be presented in a plenary session.

Costs

There is no conference fee. **Conference meals and accommodation will be covered for invited participants.** In cases where financial assistance is not available from a researcher's university, we may be able to offer a limited number of travel grants.
