3rd Berlin Workshop on Empirical Public Economics: Gender Economics

The aim of this workshop is to bring together an international group of labor and experimental economists. Topics of interest include, but are not limited to:

- Interactions between gender norms, institutions and economic outcomes
- The role of the firm and technology
- The nature of discrimination and implicit biases
- The role of gender stereotypes, norms or identity in economic decision making
- Labour market determinants and consequences of domestic violence
